# FRENCH IMMERSION CAMPS

## Camp Bienvenue

**Half-day camp for children entering Pre-K (age 3) / Camp pour les enfants entrant en petite section de maternelles**

Specifically designed to facilitate the transition for new students entering the school this year, this half-day camp is an ideal opportunity to discover the school and get acquainted with the language, the teachers and the environment. Activities include songs, arts and crafts, games and various outdoor activities.

## Camp Découvertes I & II

Activities include arts and crafts, games, singing with Julie, beach activities, water park visits, story time and much more, including a weekly field trip. Let's discover the world!

## Back to French I & II

**I - Full day camp for children entering Jr-K & K (ages 4-5)

The goal of this immersion program is to help students who may not have used French during the summer get ready for the start of the school year, as well as to help those starting at the Lycée next fall. It will provide your child an active and fun transition back into the language. Music will be the theme for week 1, while week 2 will give students an opportunity to explore the City.

**Full day camp for children entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> Grades (ages 6-10) / Camp pour les enfants du CP au CM2**

Run by experienced Lycée English teachers, this camp will provide children with the opportunity to work in small groups (6 students maximum) at their current reading/writing levels in English. Children will participate in English reading and writing workshops designed to meet their specific individual needs. These workshops, focused around reading, will include fun and creative activities such as art projects, word games, poetry drama, book discussions, poster creations, etc. Children will also go on weekly field trips and beach parties (every Tuesday and Friday) with other camp groups. A great combination of academics and FUN!

This is a great educational opportunity and gets kids excited about technology while building confidence with their own abilities.
